



Announcement from Thungkhli Provincial Police Station Regarding anti-bribery policy
(Anti-Bribery Policy)

According to the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E. ๒๐๑๘, Section ๑๒๘, paragraph one, prohibits any government official from receiving property or any other benefits. Which may be calculated as income from anyone? In addition to assets or benefits that are appropriate according to laws, rules or Regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of the law. Except for receiving property or any other benefits through ethics according to the criteria and amounts specified by the NACC and the Code of Ethics for Police Officials ๒๐๒๑, Section ๒ (๒) Honesty. Performing duties according to law Regulations of the Royal Thai Police with transparency Do not display behavior that has implications for illegal exploitation. Responsible for human rights duties Be ready to receive audits and accept responsibility. have a good conscience Consider society and item ๒ (๔) think of public benefits more than personal benefits, have public spirit, cooperate, unite and sacrifice in doing benefits for the public. and create benefits and happiness for society together with the reform plan Countries in preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct (revised edition) determining important reform activities, activity ๔ Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent. Without benefit, Goal ๑, Section ๑.๑, for all government agencies Announced as an organization that all government officials will not accept gifts. and all kinds of gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy) Therefore, in order to prevent conflicts between personal and public interests (Conflict of Interest), accepting bribes, gifts, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties. Thungkhli Provincial Police Station Therefore, guidelines for anti-bribery practices have been established. (Anti-Bribery Policy) has the following details:

Objective

๑. To prevent or reduce the opportunity to receive bribes. Conflicts of interest in various forms to police officers under its jurisdiction Thungkhli Provincial Police Station
๒. To encourage police officers under the jurisdiction Thungkhli Provincial Police Station Have a conscience in Refusal to accept gifts and gifts of all kinds in the performance of duties.
๓. To create a moral and transparent organizational culture. (Organization of Integrity) of the bureaucracy to be strong and sustainable.-๒-

- ๔. To determine measures, guidelines, and mechanisms to prevent giving/receiving bribes or What other benefits
- ๕. To set guidelines for receiving entertainment fees. or gifts of executives and police officers under the SThungkhli uphanburi Provincial Police Station To be in accordance with the law and related regulations
- ๖. To support and enhance operations under the national strategy, master plan under national strategy and the national reform plan for preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct. It is also part of the guidelines for evaluating morality and transparency in government agencies (Integrity and Transparency Assessment: ITA).

Scope

Applicable to police officers under the jurisdiction Thungkhli Provincial Police Station, all officers

Definition

“Bribe” means property or other benefits given to a person. for that person to act or refraining from doing anything in the position whether it is legal or illegal. as desired by the person paying the bribe, including accepting gifts, favors, and facilitation fees. A symbol of goodwill, accepting donations, accepting adoptions, and similar benefits. When there is an offer, giving or receiving that can be considered a cause. As a result, it is a bribe and includes giving or receiving later.

“Gifts, presents, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties” means money, property, services, or any other benefits that have value and include tips. Government officials receive in addition to salary, income, and government benefits in normal cases and affect decisions, approvals, permissions, or anything else in performing their duties in a manner that benefits the provider in a dishonest way. Gifts, either in the past, at the time of receiving, or in the future

“Property” means property and intangible objects. which may have a price and may be held You can keep it like money, houses, cars, stocks.

“Receiving property or any other benefits in an ethical manner” means receiving property or Any other benefits from relatives or people given on various occasions Usually according to tradition or culture or given according to the etiquette practiced in society

“Relatives” means parents, descendants, brothers and sisters. or sharing the same father or mother, uncle, aunt, spouse, parent or descendant of the spouse, adopted child or adoptee.

“Other benefits” means things of value. including price reductions

Receiving entertainment, receiving services, receiving training or anything else of the same nature
“Performing duties” means an action or performance of duties by a government official in an appointed position. or has been assigned to perform any duties or

to be acting on behalf of the government in any duty, either in general or and specifically as a police officer as required by law Powers and duties or acts in accordance with the powers and duties specified by law to be the powers and duties of the police.

“Commander” means a person who has the authority to command, supervise, monitor, and inspect police officers under his command. Thungkhli Provincial Police Station

“Subordinate” means subordinate police officers. Thungkhli Provincial Police Station, all officers In addition to the commander

Guidelines for preventing bribery

๑. Prohibited police officers under the supervision All Thungkhli Provincial Police Station members are involved in giving or receiving all forms of bribes, whether directly or indirectly.
๒. Prohibited police officers under Suphanburi Provincial Police Station: Every officer solicits or accepts bribes for personal benefit or the benefit of others.
๓. Follow the anti-corruption policy. without getting involved with corruption whether directly or indirectly
๔. Performance of duties must be carried out in accordance with regulations, police discipline and related laws. Strictly
๕. Do not do anything. that is considered giving or receiving a bribe
๖. Supervise the disbursement of expenses of affiliated agencies in accordance with the law. Strictly related regulations
๗. Receiving donations or financial support, whether in the form of money, objects, or property, for any activity or project. Must strictly comply with rules, regulations, and announcements. and have a receipt or evidence Receiving money for every report
๘. Receiving property or any other benefits in accordance with good conduct for police officers under the supervision Thungkhli Provincial Police Station, all officers comply with the announcement. The National Anti-Corruption Commission regarding the criteria for receiving property or other benefits based on the ethics of officials ๒๐๒๐ is strictly enforced.

Measures to manage policy violations

၁. Violation is not compliance with this policy. May be subject to disciplinary action or criminal prosecution. Or other related laws Including direct supervisors who ignore wrongdoing or acknowledge that there is Wrongdoing but not taking Thungkhlicorrect action which has disciplinary punishment To the point of being fired from government service.

၂. Failure to be aware of this policy announcement and/or related laws cannot be used. It can be an excuse for not complying.

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၃. The commander according to the Police Department Order No. ၁၂၁၂/၁၆၆၆, dated ၁ October ၁၆၆၆, has the authority and duty to supervise the subordinates under his control. Adhere to and comply with this policy. strictly

Monitoring measures

၁. Superintendent of Thungkhli Provincial Police Station Declaration of intent to manage the agency Honestly, honestly, transparently and in accordance with the principles of good governance. By publishing public relations to government officials. Police under the jurisdiction and external stakeholders know

၂. The commander, according to the Police Department Order No. ၁၂၁၂/၁၆၆၆, dated October ၁, ၁၆၆၆, shall have the authority and duty to supervise, monitor, and inspect subordinate police officers under his supervision to conduct themselves in accordance with this announcement. In the event that an action that violates this announcement is found Report to the superintendentThungkhliProvincial Police Station will be informed immediately.

၃. Thungkhli Police Station Arrange for review and improvement of compliance guidelines as appropriate or according to changes in various factors. significant

၄. To the administrative departmentThungkhliProvincial Police Station Prepare statistics on receiving bribes or receiving gifts. or any other benefits from performing duties along with problems and obstacles reported to the superintendentThungkhliProvincial Police Station Know every quarter

Measures to protect complainants/informers and maintain Confidentiality

๑. Consideration of complaints Set the level of secrecy and protect those involved according to regulations. Concerning the maintenance of government secrets, B.E. ๒๐๐๑, and submitting the matter to the agency for consideration, the information provider and the complainant may be in trouble, such as Complaints against civil servants are initially considered government secrets if they are identity cards. Consider only the cases with specified evidence. The surrounding circumstances are clearly evident and only certain witnesses can be identified. Reporting information on influential people must conceal the name and address of the complainant. If the name and address of the complainant is not concealed, the relevant agencies must be informed and provide protection to the complainant as follows. "Let the commander use it. Discretion and order as appropriate to protect the complainant, witness, and person who provides information in the investigation and investigation so that they do not have to suffer harm or injustice that may result from making a complaint, being a witness, or providing that information." In cases where there is, specifying the name of the accused must protect both the complainant and the respondent. Because the matter has not yet gone through the process fact check And it might be bullying. accused of suffering and can be damaged, and in the case where the complainant specifies in the request to conceal or do not wish to disclose the name of the complainant Agencies must remain anonymous. The complainant informs the respondent agency. This is because the complainant may have suffered as a result of the complaint.

๒. When there is a complaint The complainant and witnesses will not be subject to any action. that affects duties work or living If any action is necessary, such as separating the workplace to prevent the complainant, witness, and the accused from meeting, etc., consent must be obtained from the complainant and the witness.

๓. Requests from the injured party, the complainant, or witnesses, such as requests to move the workplace or methods for preventing or solving problems. Should be considered by responsible persons or agencies as appropriate.

๔. Provide protection to the complainant from being harassed.
